We would like to welcome everyone to McNamee Angus Ranch and Cook Angus 38th annual production sale, February 19, 2026 at Miles City Livestock Commission, Miles City Montana. It is our great honor to be teaming up with the McNamee family again. We truly appreciate everyone's interest in our programs and attending the sale. It warms our hearts to have so much support and assistance from all our family, friends, and customers.

2025 has been a whirlwind year with outstanding prices for the cattle industry. We all know the long hours, obstacles and sacrifices people in agriculture consistently make. Seeing more profitability is a welcome sight. We also know that most everything we use and need to produce our product continue to rise.

This year Cook Angus will be offering 27 Coming 2-year-old bulls ready to go to work, some suitable for heifers. 18 Yearling bulls with most being suitable for heifers. This year's offering is one of the most impressive and uniform groups we've had. Bulls will be registered by sale time, except ones marked commercial. Live online bidding will be provided by Frontier Live.

Also selling will be 40 home-raised F1 black baldy bred heifers. These heifers are bred to Cook Angus bulls and McCumber Cow Power 118 sons. Heifers will have been preg checked twice by sale time and have had all breeding shots. Heifers have been grazing corn stalks, protein, and a little hay when needed.

At Cook Angus our pride is on cow families-building profitable herds. Starting with easy-fleshing, no-nonsense females that breed back every year on grass. Our cows are moderate-framed, deep-ribbed, with tight, well-attached udders and the kind of foot and leg structure that keeps them working into their teens. Our bulls are stacked with generations of elite proven cow power. Maternal traits-backed by dams with high pregnancy rates and sustained productivity. Producing efficient, high-performing replacement females that lower costs and maximize lifetime returns in commercial herds.

We continue our pledge and responsibility in raising quality Angus cattle for all our friends, old and new. We appreciate the continued support from family, neighbors, and friends. THERE IS A DIFFERENCE!

Located in Rosebud County, SE Montana along Rosebud Creek, the ranch features diverse native and reclaimed range with cool and warm-season grasses, riparian hardwoods, and pine-juniper ridges. Eastern Montana's harsh weather helps sort the herd naturally.

Cook Angus is built on moderate-framed Black Angus females: structurally sound, with classic Angus heads, smooth shoulders, deep hindquarters, tight level udders, small teats, sound feet, and calm temperaments. We prioritize fertility, longevity, mothering ability, and self-reliance; producing productive females that calve unassisted, breed back, and raise strong calves with minimal inputs. We never compromise for open, hard-keeping, or high-headed cows.

Cattle graze and rotate through native and introduced pastures year-round with free-choice salt and mineral. Wells and pipelines provide water. Winter feeding is minimal hay plus DDG or ADM Roughage Buster as needed. Registered and commercial cows run together except during breeding.

Herd bulls are home-raised or carefully selected from proven programs (occasional AI) to maintain consistent, functional genetics—no fad-chasing or extreme numbers. We raise cattle that thrive in tough native environments, require little labor, and remain productive into their teens: quiet money-makers that just do their job.

Two-year-old bulls are summered on Rosebud Creek, in an intensive grazing rotation on native and introduced forage until mid-November. At that time we start hand feeding Hubbard bull developer, DDG's, and long stem hay in 40 acres. Yearling bulls are weaned first part of November and hand fed Hubbard bull developer, DDG'S, chopped hay, straw, and

Flax tubs. We try to abide by Jacks star rating on heifer bulls: 4-star, sleep all night calving ease. 3-star, little more growth and weight at weaning.

The EPD's are estimations: formulated using sire and dam EPD's. We emphasize functional and economical traits rather than chasing numbers. Most of the bulls have been registered, except those listed as commercial. Two-year-old bulls are virgin, except for bulls we used and they will be trich tested. They will also have passed a fertility and semen test prior to sale day. Yearling bulls will be fertility and semen tested, vaccinated with Multi Min 90 and Foot Rot prior to delivery. All bulls will have a full vaccination program along with being poured. If a yearling bull does not pass a test, we will replace him with a bull of equal value or refund your money. Cook Angus retains half semen interest in all bulls selling.

Two-year-old bulls can be taken home sale day for a \$50 head discount or will be delivered as soon as possible after the sale. Yearling bulls will be taken back to our ranch and fed until May 1st then delivered.

GUARANTEE

We guarantee our bulls to be breeders for the first year, however we do not guarantee against buyers' negligence or act of God. Bulls selling for \$6000 or more will be covered for 50% if they are injured in the first breeding season. Breeding season is considered the first 90 day-period following the first turnout of bulls.

50% of the value of the injured bull, minus half the salvage value, will be given as credit towards a bull in the next sale or towards a replacement bull if one is available. All injured bulls must be diagnosed by a veterinarian. Notify us as soon as possible if injury occurs prior to being sold. All claims must be made before September 15, 2026.

The two-year-old bulls we'll be selling are all virgin bulls that we've never offered for sale. They were fed the bull challenger pellets and ground hay last year through the winter and early spring, then they were moved to pasture. I once again heard the American Angus Association's smart ass radio ad against our "impostor" Angus bulls. For an outfit that lives in a glass house, they throw a lot of rocks. **Since we don't register our bulls**, they consider us imposters. Our EPDs are figured here and are based on each bull's sire and dam, they're not inflated like the Angus Association's. In fact, we believe our EPDs to be more accurate than theirs. The average reported weaning weights from 2007 to 2022 increased 11 pounds, while their average weaning weight EPD increased from 39 to 69. Their average

yearling weight EPD went from 69 to 116 for the same period, but the average reported yearling weights in 2007 were 1136 pounds and in 2022 they were still 1136 pounds. We've also never knowingly registered and/or sold a known carrier of a genetic defect. I'll get out my Websters, maybe that's the definition of "impostor."

That brings up the next point. The EPD's on all our 2yr old bulls are the same, because they've been right at or near these same numbers for years and we haven't changed anything.


